On your child's party day with the exception of our Nursery children, they should wear their normal school clothes and take their party clothes with them in a bag. Children will then be invited to change into their party clothes at the beginning of the afternoon session. Nursery children should wear their party clothes to their respective session.

This year all P1-7 children are again being offered lunch and party food for the price of a dinner ticket (£2.15) For this ticket they will receive soup and a sandwich at their normal lunch time and during their party time they will sit down to party food - a plate of sandwiches, sausage rolls, crisps, vegetable sticks and fruit followed by jelly and ice cream. Diluting juice and water will also be served. We would assume that the vast majority of pupils will use a dinner ticket and partake in this option however; if your child wishes to take a packed lunch then this is perfectly fine (I would strongly suggest that you pack a lunch of two halves - something that they can eat at lunchtime and something that they can eat later when their class are having party food in the afternoon.
