

Primary 4/5 Newsletter for Term 3 2017 - 2018

Robert Burns / The Blue Planet

Firstly, we will be completing our Electricity tasks, finding out about Robert Burns and learning some Scots poetry. Then we will be 'travelling' to the Oceans and Seas of the world as we find out about the Blue Planet and transform the classroom into under the sea. We will be finding out where the Oceans and Seas are, about animal and plant life, how people use it, what people get from the sea and how people pollute the sea. We will be finding out about submersibles, shipwrecks and Atlantis and why the Oceans are so important. We will be problem solving, creating, researching and taking on challenges. We will also be working on an individual Ocean animal project in class and as part of homework.



Literacy

We will continue to work towards specific individual targets to improve the quality of our writing. We will be looking at Scots / Burns poems, writing poetry, researching, taking notes and creating fact files and reports for our topic.

RME

In RME we will continue to look at the stories from the Old Testament and, as Easter approaches, the crucifixion of Jesus.

Numeracy and Mathematics

This term we will continue to improve upon our number calculations by playing various mental games. We will be focussing on the 3x and 6x tables. We will continue working on the next steps in shape, processing information and learning to tell the time or working with timetables and differences in time. It would be helpful if parents / carers could encourage their child to practise telling the time when an opportunity arises at home.

Homework will continue like last term to be given out on a Monday for return on Thursday. If anything is unclear, please ask.

PE is mainly on a Tuesday and Thursday this term. We will be trying to improve team skills, sportsmanship, and fitness though netball, circuit training, hockey and gymnastics.
