Dear parents/carers,

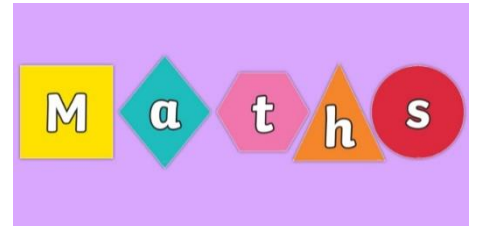

Literacy

We will continue to provide experiences in writing, reading, and listening and talking. Writing this term will have an emphasis on poetry, fictional writing and also using a wider range of VCOP



in our writing. There will be opportunities for pupils to choose a library book which they can take home to read. I encourage you to read where possible at home with books you already have, library books or explore online options of appropriate level books, which I am more than happy to help with. Reading books will also go home with pupils for them to practise their reading skills at home. Reading books will go home on a Monday or Tuesday. Our library slot will be on a Friday. If pupils wish to take home a new library book on a Friday then their old one will need to be returned before borrowing a new one.

Maths

In maths, we will continue to focus on the four operations as well as looking at fractions and measure. We will apply these skills to real world situations.

Topic

Our topic this term will be Titanic. We will be looking at the features of the titanic, the events that took place, the life of the passengers on the Titanic and the difference between the Titanic and the ships that we use today.

Outdoor Learning

Outdoor learning will be on a Thursday afternoon. We will be out in all weathers therefore, please make sure that your child comes prepared with appropriate footwear and clothing.
